# Grants for Faculty Leading Study Away Initiatives Guidelines - REDISCOVERY GRANTS For travel during 2025-2026 (revised February 2025)

The Rediscovery Grant is focused on providing financial support for faculty who have already led or taught in a study away program and who want to revisit previous destinations in order to implement significant changes to already existing programs, and/or would benefit from a visit that would enrich learning goals and/or acknowledge local changing circumstances.

Eligible applicants are faculty who are leading study abroad/away programs currently or led them in the past.

**Total Available Funding:** \$10,000

### **Maximum award for Program:**

International Trips: Up to \$3,000Domestic Trips: Up to \$1000

**Submission and Deadline:** Submit your documentation to the Director of International and Off Campus Programs (IOP), Dr. Steven Duke (<a href="mailto:stevenduke@augsutana.edu">stevenduke@augsutana.edu</a>). Applications will be reviewed by the IOP Committee. Review of submissions will start on March 21, 2025 and will continue until available funds are depleted.

#### **Proposal Guidelines**

- 1. Applicants should address the following:
  - a. Justification: submit a document that addresses the following
    - i. Explain the relationship between the academic subject and the destination
    - ii. Why is this rediscovery trip needed in order to introduce necessary modifications
    - iii. Describe partners providing logistical support
  - Itinerary: what location will be visited during this rediscovery trip. Dates should also be included
  - c. Estimated Travel Budget
  - d. Approximate dates of travel (to determine which fiscal year your grant would be eligible for)

#### 2. Criteria of selection:

- a. Priority will be given to first time applicants
- b. Proposal demonstrates convincingly that the trip will introduce relevant modifications and update course content and activities
- c. Support from Department Chair

## **Required Report**

If your proposal is approved and funding is allocated for the proposed travel, it is expected that you will work with IOP Director Steven Duke to plan your proposed trip. Following completion of the international travel, it is expected that you will submit a written report describing your funded trip and what you accomplished.
